

Coronavirus Indemnity

Is the Trust involved in treating patients suffering from Coronavirus (including using emergency volunteers, medical students, retired healthcare workers and medical practitioners from other disciplines)?



Coverage will continue as usual under CNST but only for NHS activities carried out on behalf of an NHS Trust or GP practice (i.e. by those employed).

YES

The Secretary of State will provide indemnity for clinical negligence liabilities of healthcare workers and others arising from NHS activities responding to coronavirus. This will be through the existing CNST scheme or by establishing a separate scheme.

INDEMNITY INCLUDES



Clinical negligence liabilities arising from NHS activities connected to diagnosis, care and treatment of those with coronavirus or those suspected of, or at risk from, the disease



Liabilities for healthcare workers and others providing NHS activities not related to the outbreak but as a consequence of it. This will predominantly include those called to assist in the hospital and undertake activities outside their usual duties (i.e. dental nurses administering injections etc.)
